



The following instructions are designed to help you, your I-Group and invited guests receive the best possible experience of viewing this special pre-release movie. Please review *all* of these instructions prior to actually viewing the movie for the first time.

SET UP - To Be Done At Your Earliest Convenience

- STEP 1:** If you don't already have an account at Vimeo.com, go to <http://vimeo.com> and register for the "BASIC" plan which is free (be sure to save your username and password).
- STEP 2:** If possible, arrange to show this movie on a big screen TV (not your computer) positioned to maximize your group's viewing experience. This may mean connecting your computer to your TV with an HDMI cable.

TESTING - To Be Done 24 Hours Prior to Your Scheduled I-Group Screening Date

- STEP 3:** Connect your computer to your TV, click on the special unique pre-screening Vimeo link (which you received in your confirmation email) and play the movie full screen to test sound and picture quality. If picture quality is poor check your internet speed - wired connection is best if possible. **IMPORTANT: do NOT view this movie (even for testing) more than 48 hours prior to your meeting otherwise your unique Vimeo access link will no longer work!**

VIEWING - To Be Done During the Evening of Your Scheduled Screening

- STEP 4:** 30 minutes before your meeting repeat everything you did in STEP 3 above and pause the movie at the beginning so it is ready to play once everyone arrives and is checked in.
- STEP 5:** Collect \$5.00 from everyone (including yourself) as a donation for the screening, part of which goes to MKP USA.
- STEP 6:** View the movie and once completed, give everyone a few minutes to take a break etc.
- STEP 7:** Facilitate a group discussion about the movie (see page 2).

POST VIEWING - To Be Done the Day of or After Your Scheduled Screening

- STEP 8:** Go to <http://mkpusa.org/wttmg> and follow instructions found on this page for completing your forwarding of the contributions you collected.

The following are suggested discussion topics for your group to consider after the screening of the movie. While it is helpful that this is a facilitated discussion (to keep momentum going) it is also recommended that you allow for free-form interaction as well. Feel free to add your own ideas for topics on the blank lines below.

- **What did you love / hate about the movie?**
- **What, if anything, made you uncomfortable?**
- **Could you identify with any of the characters in the movie, and if so, which one(s)?**
- **What masculine themes stood out for you the most?**
(sex, money, shame, brotherhood, trust, relationship, vulnerability, authenticity, letting go, etc.)
- **What does this movie tell us about the state of masculinity in our society?**
- **How do you see this movie fitting into the conscious men's movement?**
- **What do you think was missing from the movie and could have been incorporated?**
- **How was the depicted men's group meeting like and not like a typical I-Group meeting?**
